MASTER RECEPTION COMMITTEE | ACTIVITY REPORT, LPI 2018

Since last Sektionsmöte, our reception has come and gone. As such, our work has centred around those events, involving preparations, promotions, actual hosting of the events, and post-mortems.

LIST OF EVENTS

Our reception involved six events over 11 days, all of them to some degree hosted by MRCIT. The events were: Campus tour, pub crawl, museum visit, board game night, pool & sauna night, and a sittning.

Campus Tour	Teambuilding stations were arranged throughout Lindholmen and staffed with several organizations from the IT division, so that they could introduce the place and themselves. Participating organisations were: ArmIT, digIT, DrawIT, frITid, snIT, and styrIT.
Pub Crawl	This event mostly involved being available as a group touring the existing pub crawl so that people felt they had someone to go with. It was made more complicated by Chalmers being very slow at registering their own students, so students had to purchase guest passes to join their own crawl.
Museum Visit	Originally planned as a barbeque in the park, we had to go with our second option due to poor weather conditions. On the plus side, the blue whale was open for entry.
Board Game Night	Arranged in co-operation with DrawIT, we held a night filled with board games and served the food that wasn't served at the (cancelled) barbeque.
Pool & Sauna Party	An event presenting the campus Johanneberg sauna for students.
Sittning	Finally, MRCIT planned, staffed and organised a full sittning for the new students, showing off a staple of Swedish student culture.

PROMOTION OF EVENTS

Since the routines for registering new students to Master programmes appear complicated, our main promotion effort has been centred on Facebook communication as well as physical promotion during lectures. We also attended the programme introduction lectures for all four programmes involved in our reception and are glad to report attendance from each programme on 5 out of 6 events.

POST-MORTEM

A post-mortem session has been held within MRCIT, and a questionnaire has been prepared for students to respond to for our final evaluation. These will lay the groundwork for our continuity.
