This document goes through the structure and rules for the student SM in E-sport on September 29th and 30th. It will take place in Inferno Online's facilities and we are working together with them to promote the event. The event is a part of Akademiska Spelen 2023 which is a national multisport event for students all across the country who attend any of our universities/colleges. Arrangement and format of competition

Standard tournament elimination format depending on the amount of participating teams. Group stage into elimination bracket for each game. Bo3, Bo5 etc in the playoffs. Losers bracket depending on how many teams are participating.

Both games will be played simultaneously, thus you can only register to participate in one of the two games that are featured in the tournament. First day will be groupstages and the second final day will conclude the playoffs.

Rules

Standard competition rules on both games. Each team will have a certain amount of timeouts/pauses like regular competitive play in both games.

Who can register?

The tournaments are open to any students that attend any of Sweden's universities and colleges. There can be multiple teams from the same university. No specific requirements prior to registry needed. *Alumnis of one year are allowed to participate*.

Equipment and fees

We have worked out a deal with Inferno Online as our co-hosts. They will provide us with their brand new spacious facility to host the event and their gaming setups for the participating teams. The fee is 125 SEK per participating player. The fee covers all costs to participate and use their equipment. *You may bring your own mouse, mousepad and keyboard.*

What happens if a player/team is unable to play?

If one of the players in a team is unable to play the team must find a substitute that meets the requirements to participate to continue the games. If they can not find an appropriate sub it will be deemed WO. If a team is unable to play the scheduled game will be deemed as WO.
